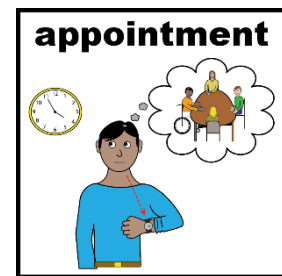

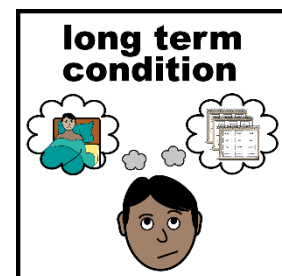
Patient Initiated Follow up Appointments

Your doctor feels you can arrange a follow up appointment, when you need it, using a new booking system.



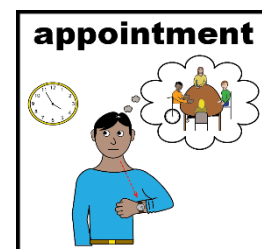

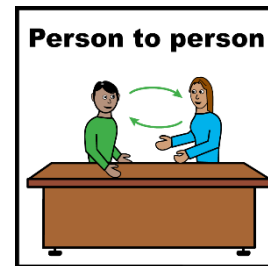
How do I book a follow up appointment?

Call <<Contactphone>> and ask for a **Patient Initiated Follow-up Appointment**. We will ask some questions about you to find out how soon your appointment needs to be.

We will also decide how you will speak to the doctor for your appointment. This can be a telephone call, video call or person to person.

Do not use a **Patient Initiated Follow up appointment** if you need medical advice, please call your GP or NHS 111. If you have a medical emergency please go to your local Accident and Emergency Department or call 999.

We will still look after you even if you do not arrange a **Patient Initiated Follow-up Appointment**. We will contact you to arrange a planned follow up appointment as part of your long-term care plan.
